- a c. The NTSI will provide a blank chart with some program timing already listed (Orations / EC meeting / General Body meeting). A realistic scientific program has to be planned around this.
- d. There should be one session devoted to problem cases. This should include both cranial and spinal cases, and deal with diagnostic or management problems, irrespective of the outcome.
- e. Neurotrauma practice has many intricate legal repercussions and there should be some lectures on this from experts.
- f. The President Elect will be the Ex-Officio Chairman of the Scientific Committee, and with the NTSI Secretary and Organising Secretary will ensure the timely and proper preparation of scientific program.
